We must continually monitor & upgrade our security mechanisms to ensure we keep our students and staff safe. This includes making improvements to the current traffic flow and drop-off/pick-up at our Jr./Sr. High.

- We aim to develop facilities and programs that encourage our graduates and teachers to stay, with more diverse projects and opportunities that emulate what we love about ED-CO.








1 LONG RANGE PLANNING CONCEPT
